

Bug Bingo – caller sheet

Ask players to cross the answers to each question out on their Bingo sheet. The questions are read out by the tutor *in the order below*. The first person to line up 5 correct answers (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal) is the winner. The point at which this is first possible is highlighted in the list of questions. Prizes are a good addition but difficult if playing remotely!

1. This organism is the cause of bacterial tonsillitis and necrotising fasciitis
2. These organisms are what we use metronidazole to treat
3. Gentamicin is toxic to the kidneys, what other unwanted effect is important?
4. This is a test used to visualise virus particles
5. This is what a Gram stain of *Staphylococcus* would look like
6. This antibiotic only covers Gram positives and covers most of them
7. This organism causes pseudomembranous colitis
8. This test is how we distinguish *S. aureus* from other staphylococci
9. This organism causes intertrigo
10. This organism carries ESBL enzymes - around 20% of UK clinical isolates display carriage
11. For this organism, ciprofloxacin (or another quinolone) is the only effective oral antibiotic
12. This antibiotic is used exclusively for staphylococcal infections
13. This is what you might see in the blood culture of someone with *Klebsiella* sepsis
14. When this is methicillin resistant it is much more difficult to treat

First line of 5 possible – diagonal line from top left

For those who don't have a line, carry on:

15. This is what *Neisseria meningitidis* looks like on microscopy
16. This organism can grow at 4 degrees c
17. This drug is used to treat syphilis and tonsillitis

Second line of 5 possible - vertical far right

18. This is a useful way to get a retrospective diagnosis of atypical pneumonia

Third line of 5 – vertical, second from far right

19. Broad spectrum antibiotics useful for ESBL producers
20. Can be treated with neuraminidase inhibitors

4th line of 5 – horizontal, bottom line

21. Useful drug if you need to treat anaerobes [*already asked this the other way round but probably will not get this far in quiz as most should have finished*]

5th line of 5 – horizontal, second from top
